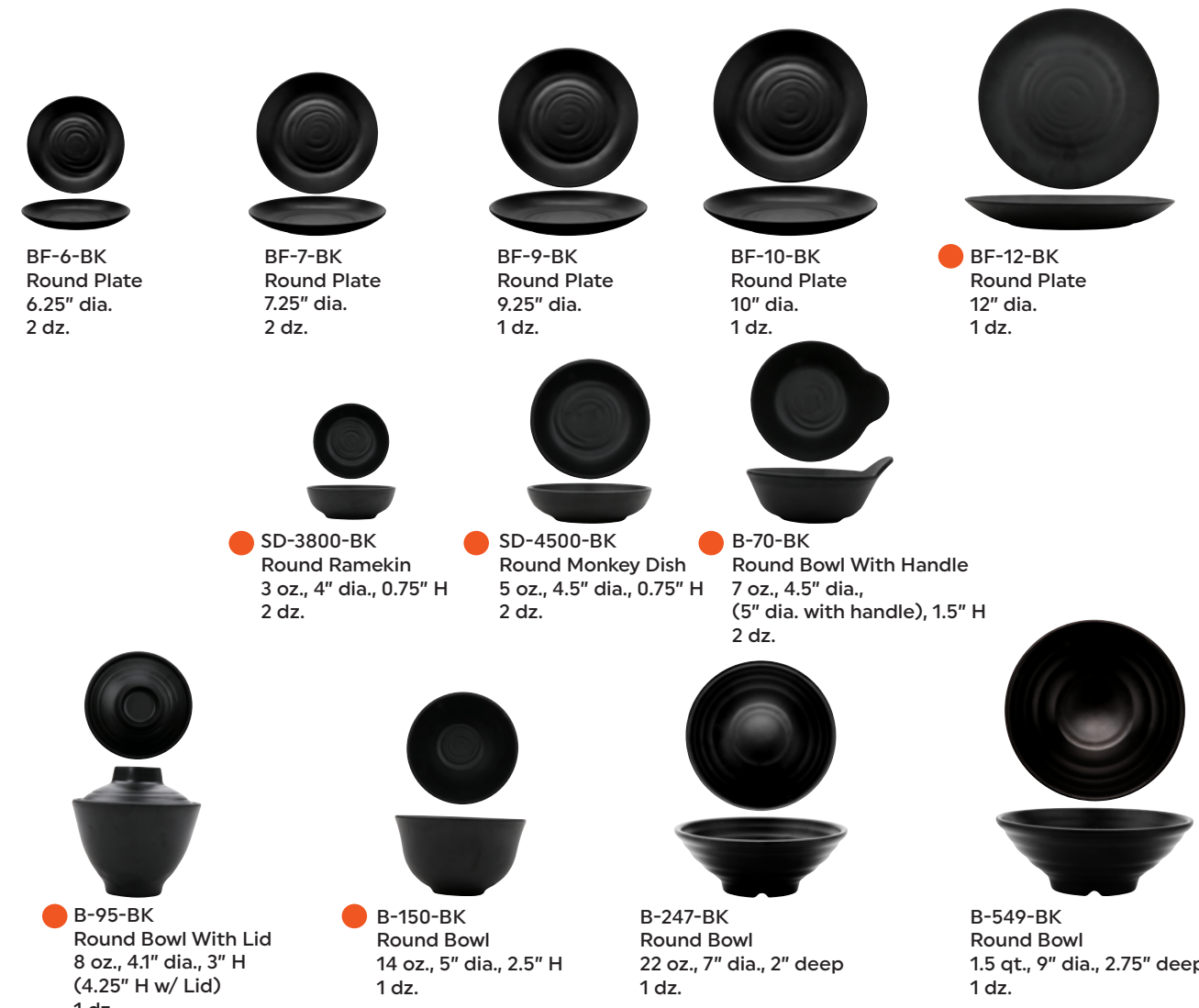

Who Should Serve on Nara?

Who Should NOT Serve on Nara?

Like all melamine, Nara has a few areas where porcelain naturally performs better. In these cases, we recommend using either a mix of porcelain and melamine or porcelain only.

- Plated entrées requiring a steak knife
- Plated entrées requiring oven or salamander finishing
- As always, melamine should not be microwaved
